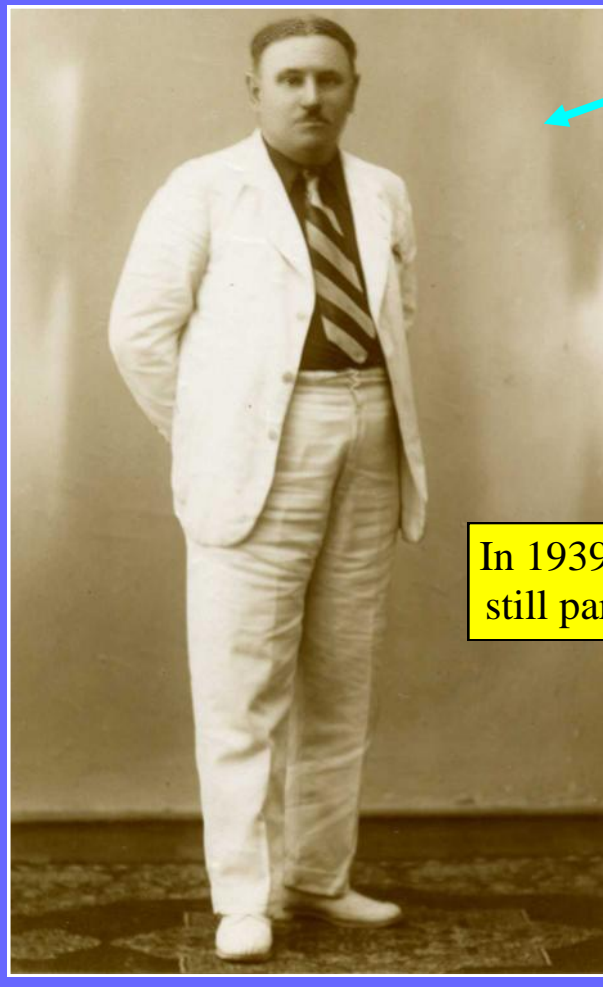

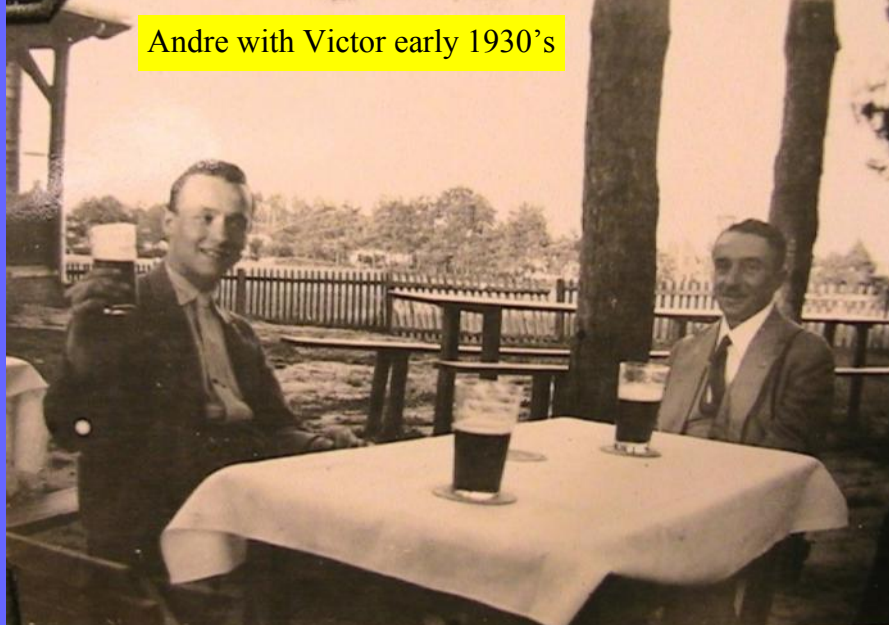
Photo was attached to letter by Andre using a bent pin (as seen here)

But in 1940 Lwów belonged to USSR



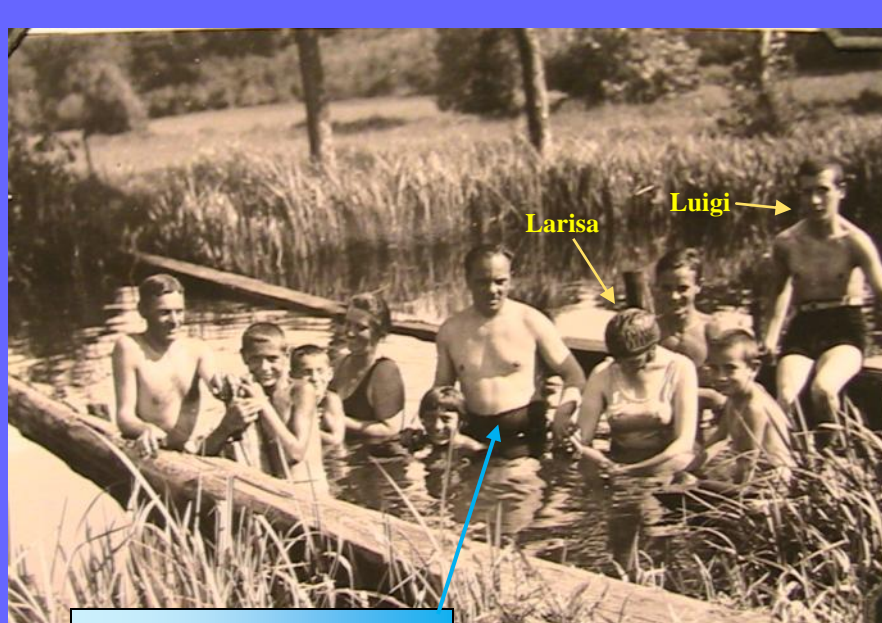
Andre with Victor early 1930's



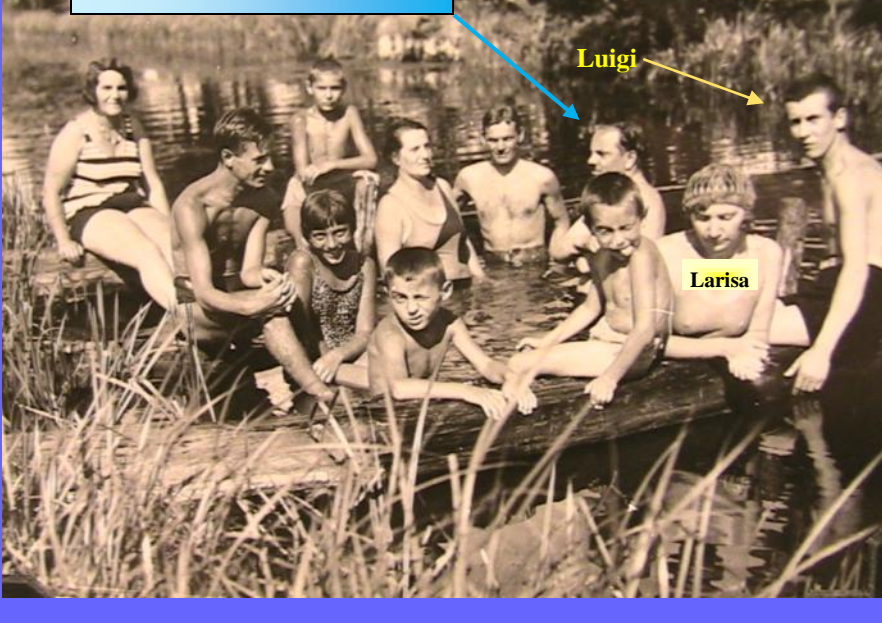

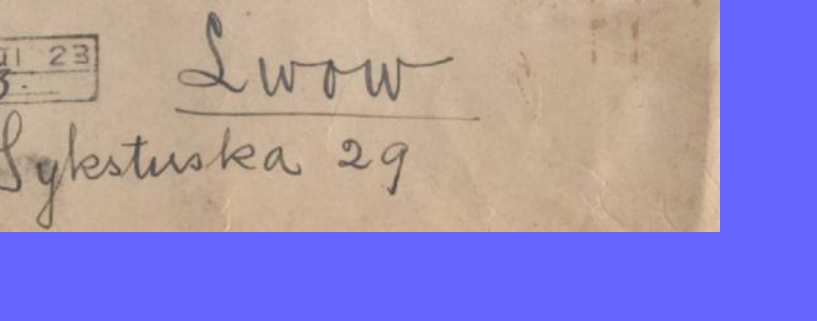

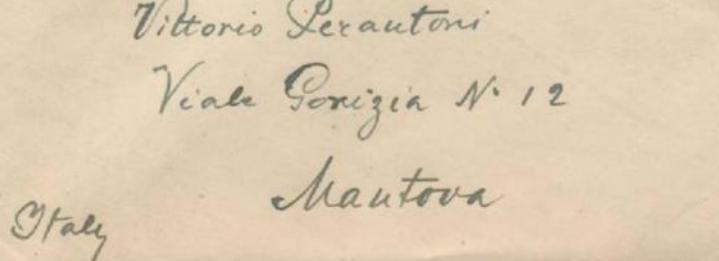
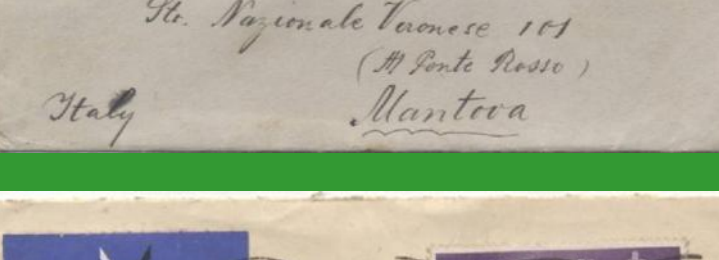
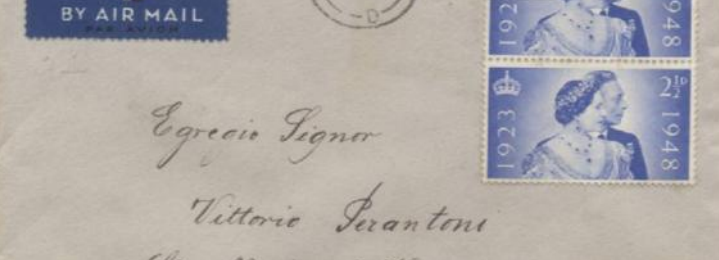
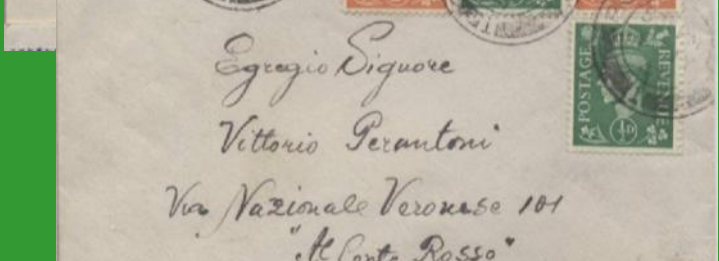
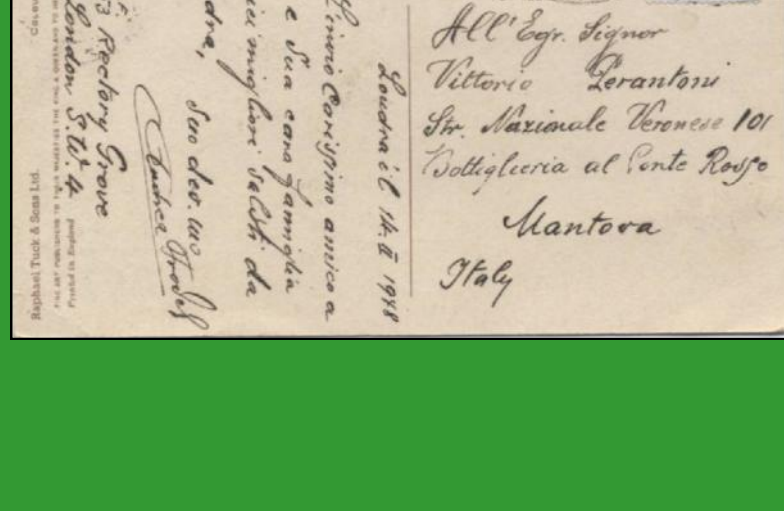
Pre-war mail from Andre' to Victor



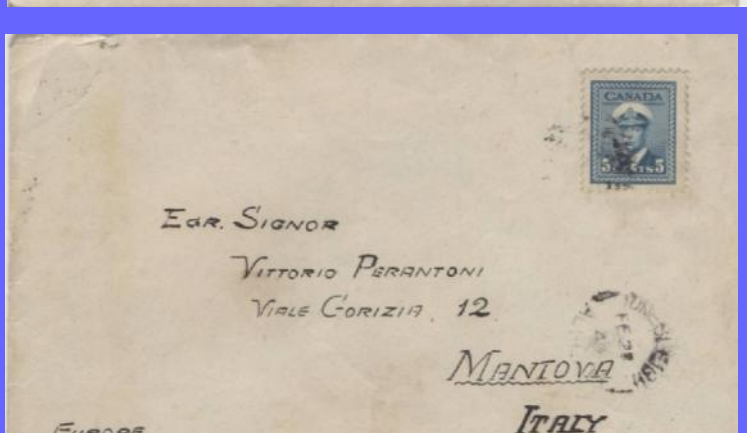
Andre was with Polish Forces attached to British Allies in Central Italy

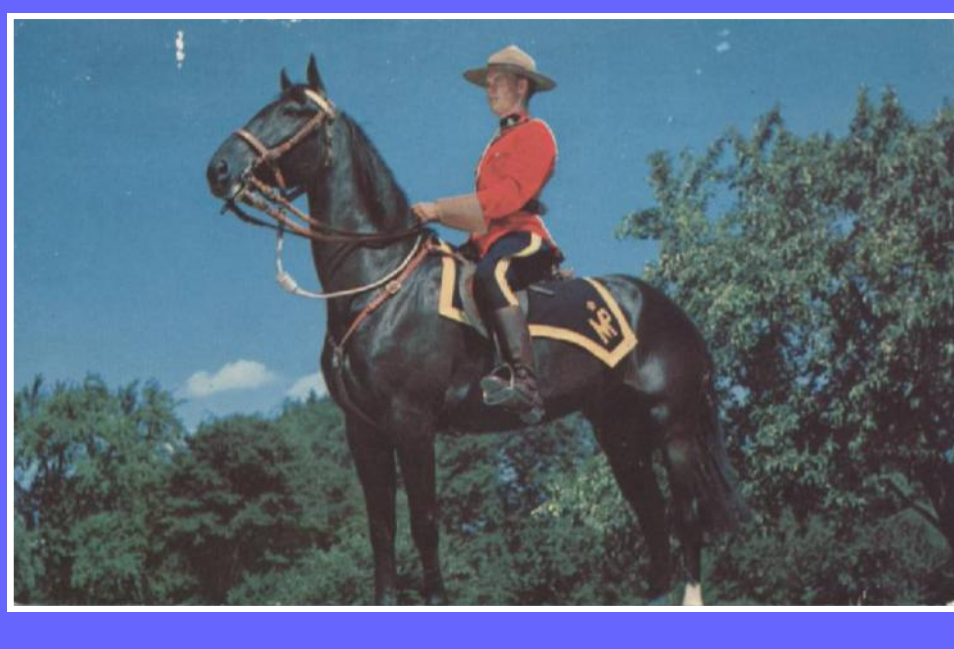
Andre's letters from Canada 1948-49
