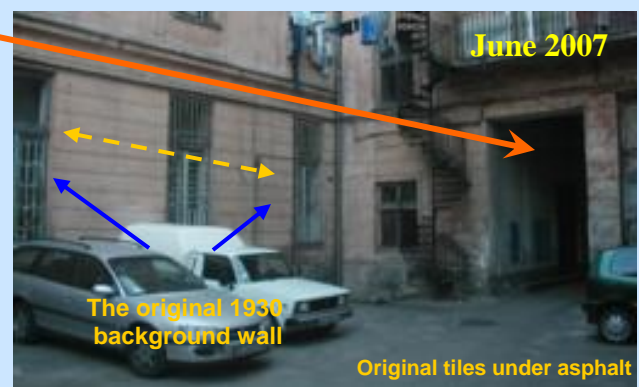

changed except the window security grates





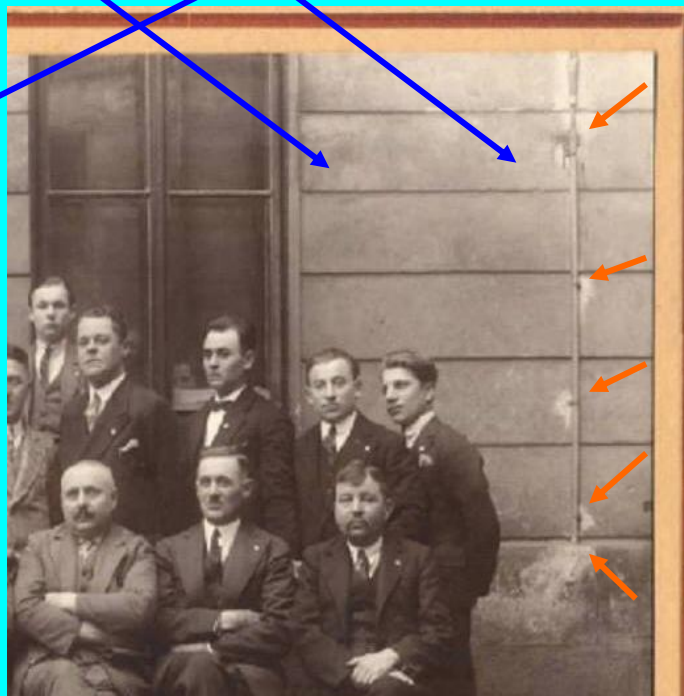
JUNE 2007 : Same electric conduit and the same conduit fastening anchors



These two pictures were taken in the exact same location, which is the inner courtyard of grandfather Carlo's winery "Italia".

The photo on right was taken circa 1929-1930, and the photo on left was taken in 2007. Note that security bars were installed directly in front of the exact same window and windowsill.

There are several other recognizable features, marks, wall-chips, cracks, and fastening anchors, identified by the arrows.
