

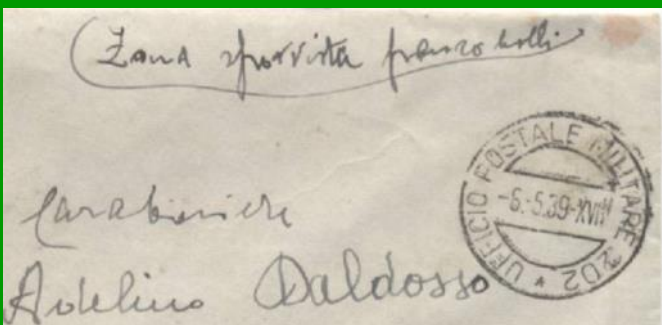
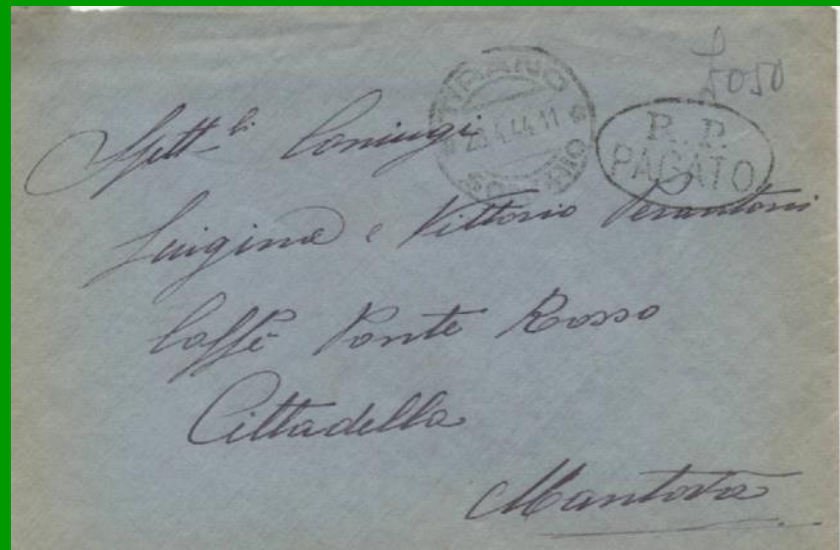
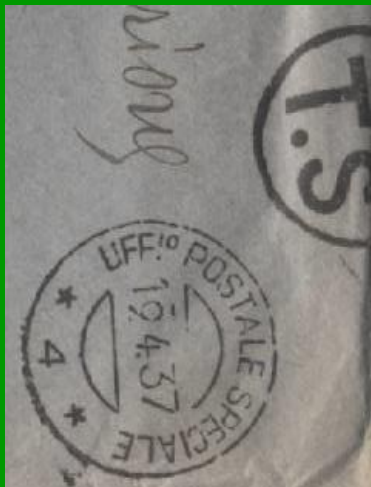
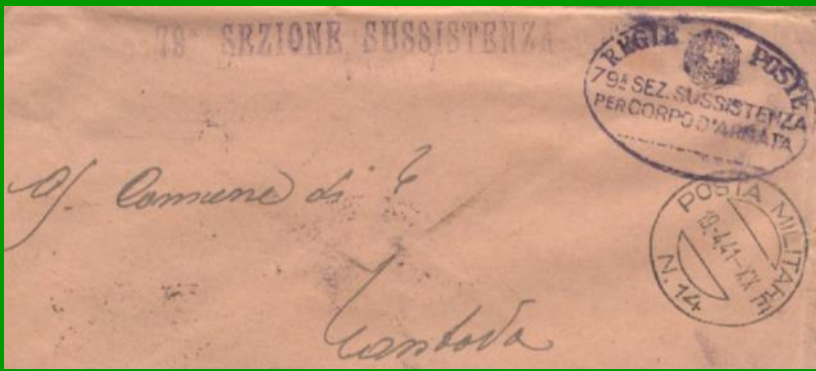
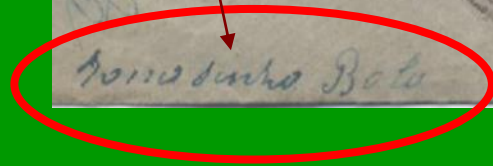
Military postmarks on war-zone mail with no stamps (taxed)

From Italian Colonies & military occupations, most from Spanish Civil War 1936-1939

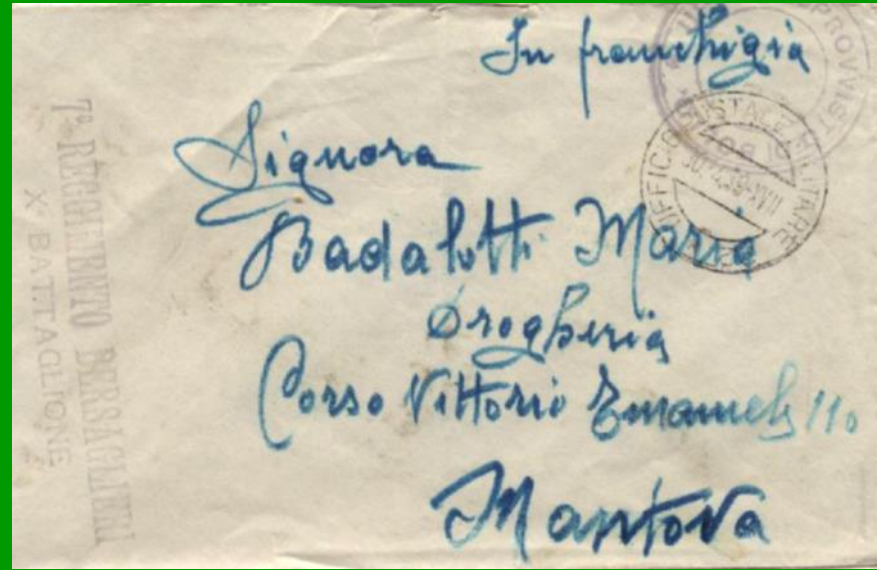
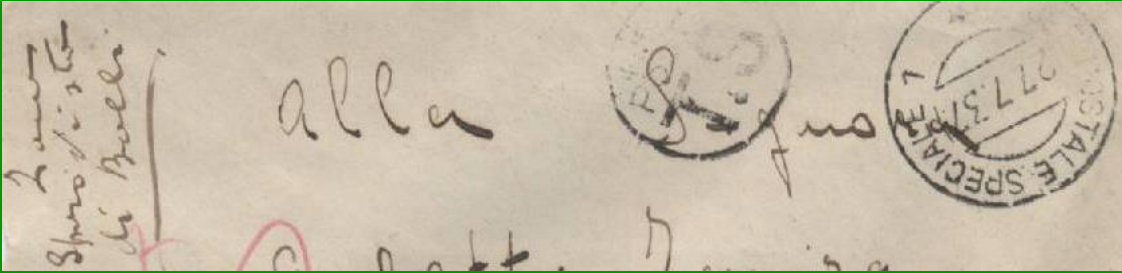
The items which appear as postmark cuttings are actually cropped images from complete envelope covers.
