These are only some of Victor's many friends from Lwow Poland : Some were Polish, Ukrainian, and Jewish. He lost contact with most of his Lwow friends due to Nazi arrests and deportations, also due to nationalist expatriations and cultural transformations which were perpetrated by the German Nazi Government and by Soviet Russia, during WW2 and also during the Cold War which followed.
